Contract Amendment to Contract No. 49GH-110 Design-Build of a Communications Based Train Control System

PURPOSE:

To authorize the General Manager to execute a Contract Amendment to the Contract No. 49GH-110 with Hitachi Rail STS USA, Inc. (Hitachi), in an amount not to exceed \$330,000,000, to perform Systems and Vehicle Integration work for the Communications Based Train Control (CBTC) project.

DISCUSSION:

On January 9, 2020, the BART Board authorized the General Manager to award Contract No. 49GH-110 to Hitachi for the Design-Build of a Communications Based Train Control (CBTC) System for the price of \$798,551,928, (including all taxes). The Contract was subsequently awarded on September 16, 2020 and executed on September 30, 2020. Notice to Proceed (NTP) was issued on November 2, 2020.

This Contract Amendment provides for the completion of the Final Design and execution of Systems and Vehicle Integration work. This scope includes, but is not limited to, development of final interface design packages, software integration activities, technical and installation support, and provision of warranty services for the CBTC System and Vehicle Interface.

As part of this Contract Amendment, Alstom will be retained by Hitachi as a subcontractor to perform the necessary CBTC-to-Vehicle interface design and integration tasks.

This Contract Amendment will also provide compensation to the Contractor for project

delays and inefficiencies due to lack of an Integration Contract between the vehicle supplier and the CBTC contractor. These delays have impacted the progress of Conceptual, Preliminary, Final Design and System Integration efforts and necessitate additional time and resources to complete the required scope of work.

The Procurement Department will review this Contract Amendment prior to execution for compliance with procurement guidelines. The Office of General Counsel will approve the Contract Amendment to form prior to execution.

This action is not anticipated to have any Fiscal Impact on unprogrammed District reserves.

ALTERNATIVES:

Not authorizing the General Manager to execute Contract Amendment will prevent the District from proceeding with the final interface and integration design activities between the Vehicle and the Communications-Based Train Control (CBTC) systems. This will result in substantial cost and schedule impacts, including, but not limited to, delays to the critical path of CBTC Contract No. 49GH-110, disruption to project milestones, and increased risk to the timely completion of the overall Transbay Corridor Core Capacity Program (TCCCP).

It is recommended that theBoard adopt the following motion.
