Most Allegations Unsubstantiated



Policy & Process Clarifications Identified

Including confidentiality, vehicle use, records handling, and communication processes.



Oversight Supports Accountability & Transparency



Employee Rights & Confidentiality

A confidentiality agreement required clarification regarding employee whistleblower and reporting rights.



Time Theft Allegations

No evidence supported allegations of time theft or manipulated time records. Overtime concerns were referred to management.



Vehicle Use Practices

District vehicle transportation practices lacked clear guidance, creating confusion about permissible use.



Public Records Request

Concerns were raised regarding the withholding of records potentially subject to public disclosure. BART is reassessing the request.



Third Rail Safety Review

BART safety officials were aware of concerns raised over required safety protocol after power is shut off.
