RE: OIG Fraud, Waste, or Abuse Investigation Reports

Attached for your consideration is the BART Office of the Inspector General's (OIG) report, *Summary of Investigations Volume III – 2026*, summarizing five completed investigations into alleged misconduct. We generally found that the five allegations lacked evidence to support wrongdoing. However, we identified the need to clarify language in a non-disclosure agreement and better communicate rules governing the use of District vehicles for non-work-related purposes.

This work shows that the OIG takes allegations of misconduct seriously and resolves them objectively. Even when claims are not substantiated, OIG independent investigations protect public trust by confirming that resources are not being misused and employees are treated fairly. Equally important, these reviews identify gaps in policies and practices that, if left unaddressed, could create future risk.

Although the OIG is not requesting action from the Audit Committee, we have designated our report as a possible action item should the Audit Committee determine that action is warranted.

We look forward to presenting the report and discussing our work with the Committee on June 18, 2026.
