SUBJECT: Special Appointments: Liaisons to San Mateo County Stations

President Foley announced at the September 11, 2025 BART Board of Directors meeting that he is re-establishing Liaison Appointments for San Mateo County Stations. These appointments would bring back the program for Directors to adopt a San Mateo County BART Station, as San Mateo County residents are not represented by an elected BART Board member.
