

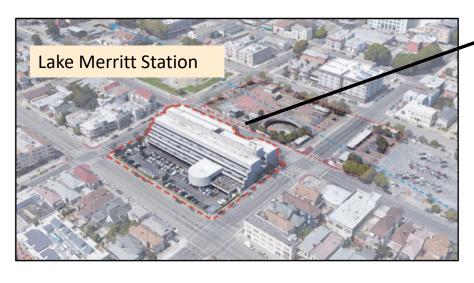

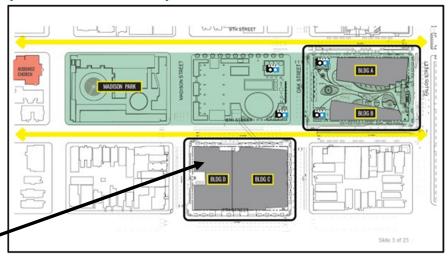


# BART PD Administrative HQ (BPD HQ) Relocation

# Current BPD HQ Located at 101 8th Street, Oakland (MET)

- Requires seismic upgrade
- Building systems aging, require replacement
- Property slated for Lake Merritt TOD





#### Planned Lake Merritt TOD

- 4 new buildings on BART-owned property
- 519 units of housing, 44% affordable
- 517,000 SF of commercial space
- 2 phases in Development Plan

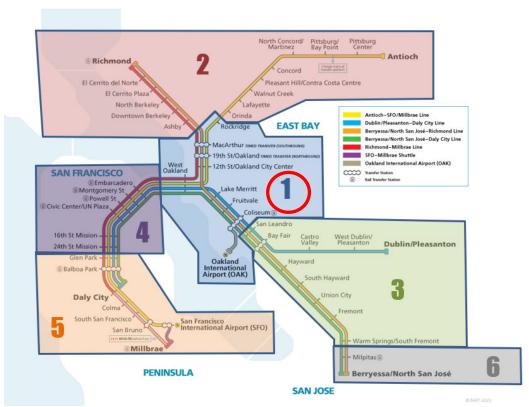

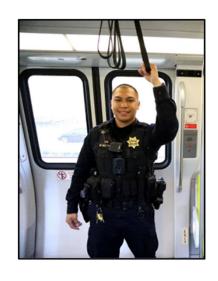
Patrol Division for Oakland core stations

- Promotes innovative policing practices



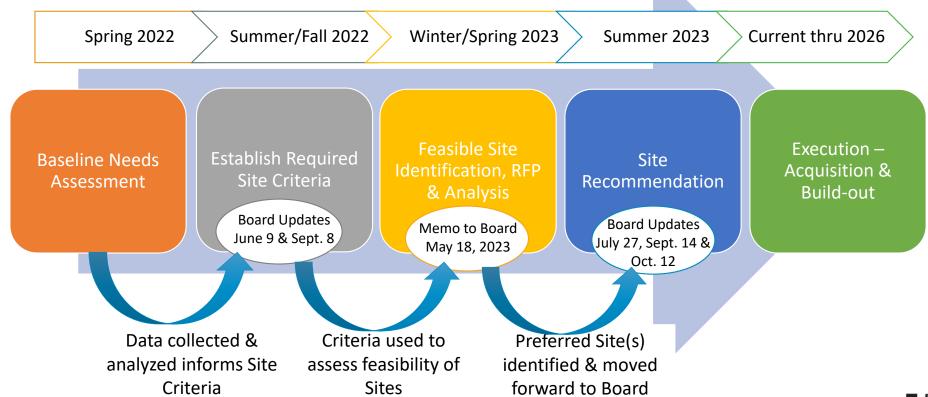


#### **Project Opportunities**

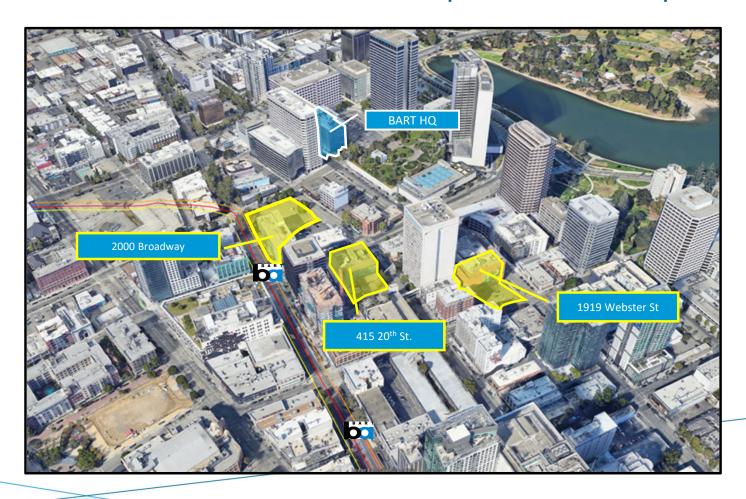

<ul><li>✓ Appropriately sized and configured building</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Can accommodate at least 65-75,000 SF facility (not too large)</li> <li>Age and condition of systems</li> <li>Appropriate parking, storage, &amp; layout</li> </ul>

- Site visits to other modernized facilities
- Continued Real Estate negotiations with private parties
- Developed funding strategy



# Map – General Location of Responsive Proposals

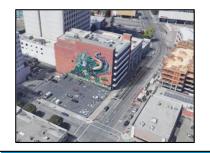

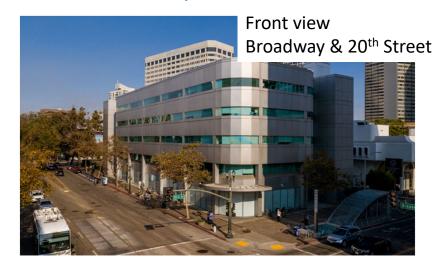
#### RFP Review Panel Recommendation is to purchase 2000 Broadway

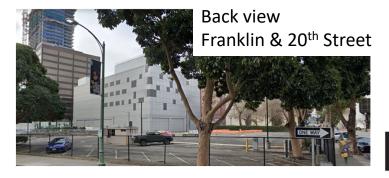
Best site option to develop a modernized Police Headquarters to attract and retain workforce and provide enhanced safety for the BART System and connections with our ridership.

- Highest score from the RFP Review Panel
- Met all required Site Criteria
- Excellent proximity to 19th St. Station & BHQ
- BART would be the building owner/operator
- Ability to control public lobby, security & all access to building
- Mitigates future market risk

#### **Purchase Price \$25.5 M**

- Plus \$765K est. closing costs (\$26,265,000)
- Estimated Closing Date in August 2024
- Owner is Kaiser Foundation







### Funding the BPD HQ Relocation Project

#### Building Acquisition ~\$26.5 Million

- Deposit & Due Diligence Costs, Source: BART Capital Project Funds
- Full purchase Price & Closing Costs in August 2024, Source: Measure RR interest earnings

#### Building Renovation – Estimated cost between \$74-96 Million

- Funding Source: seeking federal financing (loan under the TIFIA/RRIF Programs)
  - BART received a grant award to develop loan application
- If necessary, BART can reprogram existing allocations of Measure RR funds
- \$9M/year to fund BPD HQ is already included in operating forecast starting in FY27 (July 2026)

#### Next Steps

- Spring 2024
   – issue RFQ/RFP for design & construction
- Return to Board for authorization(s) to award RFP & final funding plan

# Proposed Motions BPD HQ Relocation – 2000 Broadway, Oakland

- The General Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute a Purchase and Sale Agreement with Kaiser Foundation Health Plan Inc. to purchase an office building at 2000 Broadway, Oakland CA 94612, for BART's Police Administrative Headquarters at a price not to exceed \$26,265,000 (inclusive of deposit and estimated closing costs).
- The General Manager or his designee is authorized to execute any and all agreements and other documents in order to effectuate the preceding motion
