- Service to new markets

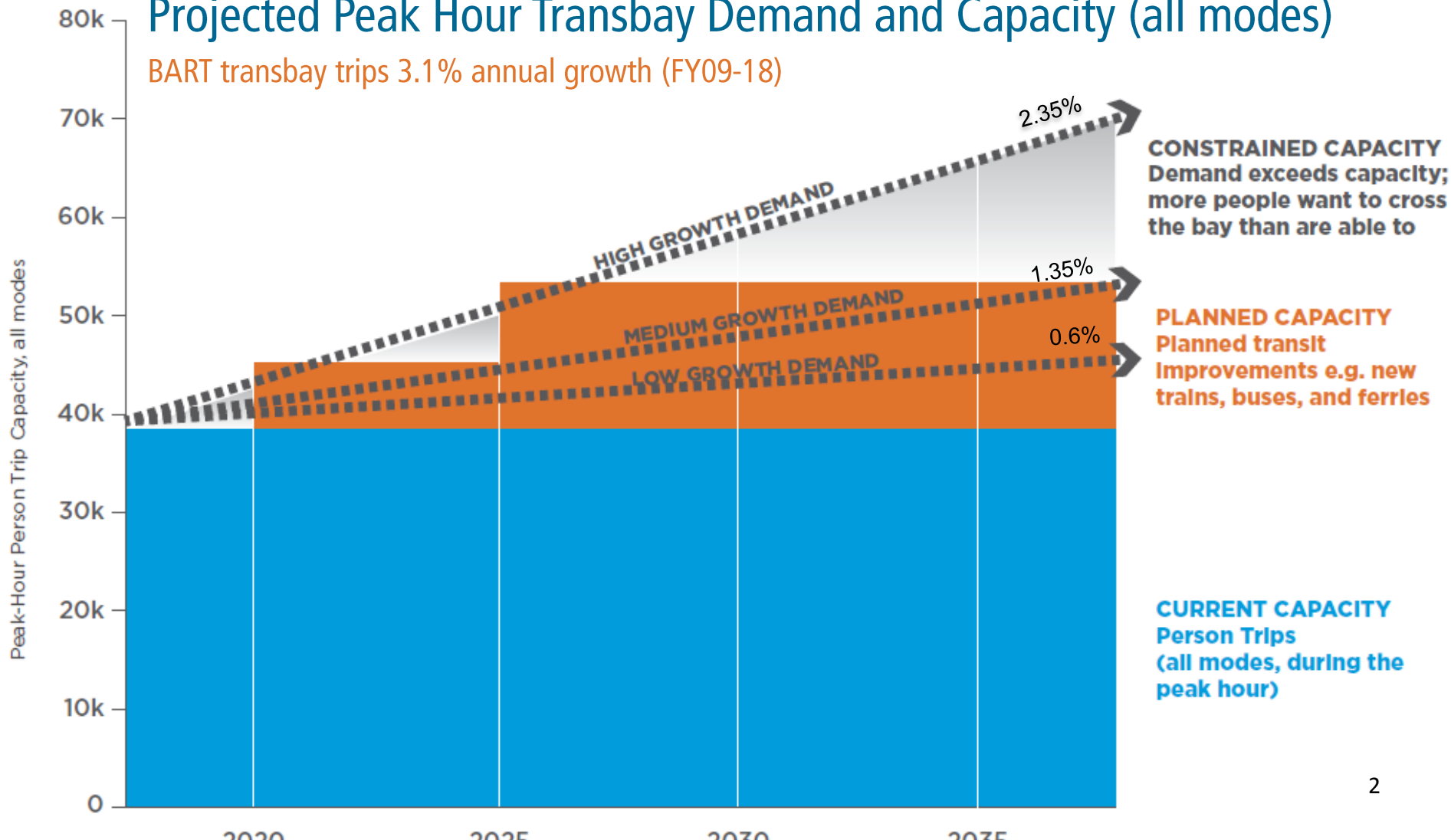


New Transbay Rail Crossing: Transbay demand



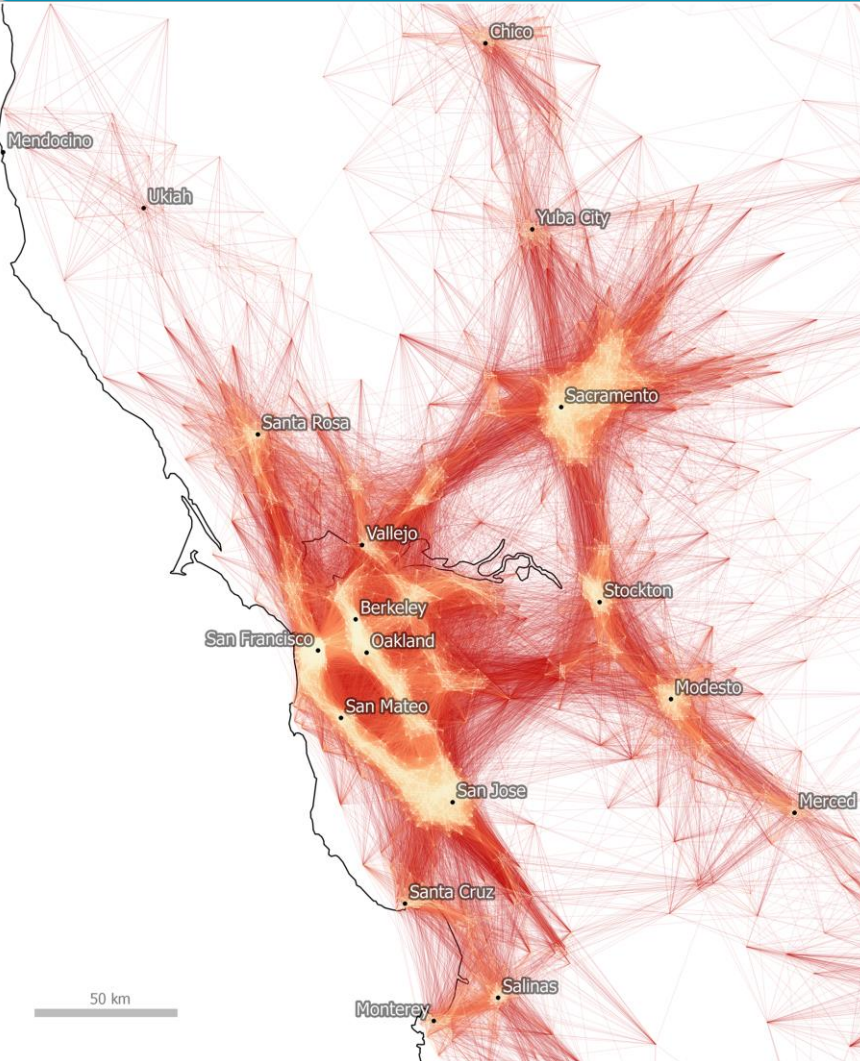
Projected Peak Hour Transbay Demand and Capacity (all modes)
