# Procurement of BARTNET Hardening Equipment: F5 IDS / IPS from SHI via a NASPO ValuePoint contract

#### **PURPOSE**:

To request Board authorization for the General Manager to execute a contract with SHI International, Corp (SHI) for the purchase of F5 IDS / IPS security systems for an amount not to exceed \$150,000.

# **DISCUSSION**:

The purpose of the project is to upgrade BART's Districtwide Operational Technology Networking Infrastructure (DOTI) for improved protection against malicious cyberattacks.

This procurement is for an amount not to exceed \$150,000 to provide a new Intrusion Detection System / Intrusion Prevention System (IDS / IPS) to protect credit card transactions from malicious cyber threats. This procurement will replace the existing end-of-life systems with new and more secure systems. The procurement includes \$25,993 for licenses and service support contracts covering one year. After the initial term, annual renewal of licenses and other ongoing support costs of approximately \$26,000 will be required from the District's Operating Budget.

This procurement will be made through the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) cooperative purchasing program approved by the Board in 2016.

NASPO ValuePoint (formerly WSCA-NASPO) is a cooperative purchasing program, aggregating the demand of all 50 states, the District of Columbia and the organized US

territories, their political subdivisions and other eligible entities.

Because the State of California participates in the NASPO program, its local agencies and districts, including BART, are authorized by California Public Contract Code section 10298 to purchase items from the suppliers awarded contracts by NASPO without further competitive bidding.

This procurement will be pursuant to the Utah ValuePoint Master Agreement Number AR2472 and the State of California Participating Addendum Number 7-17-70-40-05 with Carahsoft Technology Corp, expiring September 15, 2026. The procurement will be from SHI, an authorized re-seller of F5 equipment and services under this NASPO Master Agreement.

Pursuant to the District's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise ("DBE") Program, the Office of Civil Rights reviewed the scope of work for this NASPO ValuePoint purchase and determined that there were no DBE subcontracting opportunities; therefore no DBE participation goal was set for this purchase.

The Office of General Counsel will approve the agreement as to form before they are executed.

The Procurement Department will review the agreement to confirm compliance with the District's procurement standards.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Funding in the amount of \$150,000 for the procurement of F5 IDS / IPS security systems is included in the total project budget for project 79LV000 BARTNET System Hardening.

The table below lists funding assigned to the referenced project and is included to track funding history against spending authority. Funds needed to meet this request will be expended from the sources listed.

As of October 26, 2022, \$9,072,037 is the total budget for this project. BART has expended \$6,379,461 committed \$38,891 and reserved \$334,098 to date. This action will commit an additional \$150,000 leaving an available fund balance of \$2,169,587 in these fund sources for this project.

The Office of the Controller/Treasurer certifies that funds are currently available to meet this obligation.

There is no fiscal impact on available un-programmed District Reserves.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

The District could choose not to implement the improvements, leaving the District at greater risk of malicious cyber attacks related to credit card transactions.

The District can seek to competitively bid this procurement, which is not likely to result in lower Bid prices and will result in later delivery of the hardware and software.
