



This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your Safety and Security Certification Verification Report (SSCVR) dated May 20, 2020, which certifies the completion of the Safety and Security Certification Plan requirements for the Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) Silicon Valley Berryessa Extension Project for revenue service operations beginning June 13, 2020.

The staff of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has completed its evaluation of the SSCVR in accordance with General Order 164-E. CPUC Staff has observed implementation and testing of the elements of the plan as outlined in the SSCVR and has identified no safety nor security concerns for the BART Silicon Valley Berryessa Extension Project to be placed in service as requested.

CPUC Staff will continue to monitor the SVBX project discrepancy open items list between BART and Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) and the work by SVBX project personnel to close these out in a timely manner. Both agencies have deemed these open items not to be safety critical in nature. CPUC Staff agrees and this letter authorizes BART to initiate revenue service as requested on June 13, 2020.

Thank you and your personnel who have been instrumental in the successful completion of the Safety and Security Certification Plan requirements during the BART Silicon Valley Berryessa Extension Project operational and functional tests. I wish you every success during revenue service and look forward to continuing our cooperative association with your agency and personnel in the future.



### Revenue Service Preparedness





- Due to COVID-19 there will not be a public celebration at the new stations at this time
- Limited Commemorative Clipper Cards will be available for purchase at select ticket vending machines at the two new BART stations and select VTA Transit Centers
