

Findings

- Unmanned Storeroom access procedure:
 - Was created in 1984, making it over three decades old.
 - Does not reflect positions created in 1997 and 2001 that play a role in the movement of inventory.
 - Does not adequately incorporate use of an automated system to manage inventory that replaced paper-based process described in the procedure.
- Management accepted our findings.






Recommendations

- We recommended:
 - Updating procedure to align with current practices, positions, and automated systems.
 - Providing employees with the updated procedure and enforcing its use.
 Following appropriate performance evaluation actions when employees fail to follow the procedure.
- Management agreed to our recommendations.
 - Planned implementation January 25, 2021.
